Leader: Give thanks to the LORD; call upon his name; make known his deeds among the peoples! **People: We will sing to him, and tell of all his wondrous works!**


Leader: He remembers his covenant forever, the covenant that he made with Abraham, with Isaac, and with Jacob; an everlasting covenant!


